February 17, 2023 minutes were acknowledged and accepted. Pegi reminded volunteers to keep record of their hours. She is always surprised as to how quickly the hours add up! March it on Out held on March 25th raised close to \$2,000. Congratulations to everyone who donated and participated in this event.

District 1 AGM 2024 is to be held on April 13, 2024 in Embrun. RDHS will be hosting/organizing this AGM and is awaiting confirmation on the venue. The theme will be 'Leaping into the Leap Year – 2024'. Diane Sharp and Christine Lanthier have been coordinating efforts on this event and have a good head start. They will be taking a break over the summer period, but will need volunteers down the road.

2023 Plant Sale is fast approaching and is on schedule for this Saturday, May 20, 2023. *Friendly reminder* that the location of this event is now at the fairgrounds. There continues a need for more tables and gazebos (if available) and all contributions will be most welcomed. *Suggestion* – bring along a lawn chair or two and water. An early 7 - 7:15 a.m. arrival for all those members who signed up to volunteer would be greatly appreciated. Louise has tags available for plant donations. Anyone who has shown interest in volunteering their time in helping with the tree planting at the Burton Conservation area please note that the date of Friday, May 26th has been changed (post meeting date). The delivery of the tree seedlings has been bumped back by the nursery and it appears that this task will be more onerous than previously anticipated. Therefore, planting dates will be Monday, May 29th **and** Tuesday, May 30th. The media event with Pierre Leroux will be Tuesday, May 30th at 2:30 p.m.

Pegi made mention that the late Esther Bryant has created a quilt which she named 'Quilt of Belonging'. This quilt will be on view at the Williamstown fairgrounds from June $9^{th} - 11^{th}$.

Connie Johnston shared with the group that the Russel Trivia event held May 13th raised in excess of \$25,000 for the Mural that will be erected on the South side of the Pronto building in the downtown core. The mural will consist of photos, not actual paintings, that are enhanced/

enlarged and moveable. This mural should be available on July 13th for the Meet Me on Main Street event from 5 – 8 p.m. Admission is free. T-shirts will also be available (black only), depicting the Russel old train station for \$15/each.
