

RDHS June 19, 2023 Monthly meeting Location: Marionville Community Centre

Pegi Holtz greeted all attendees and identified washroom facilities. Linda Duhamel continues to accept 2023 RDHS memberships for the cost of \$10/year. 2023 Yearbooks are available to all registered/current members. Bookmarks are also available upon request while quantities last. May 15, 2023 minutes were acknowledged and accepted.

The 2023 Plant Sale held on Saturday, May 20, 2023 was a success. The change from the usual location at MacDougall Park to the Russell fair grounds location turned out to be a welcome change as there was shelter from the menacing rain clouds that only produced rain a half hour before the projected end time. Approximately \$3,000 was raised. The school is on board again next year to provide us with vegetable seedlings for sale. Thanks to all the volunteers who came to help and a big kudos to Marilyn MacMillan who went back after the sale and cleaned off the whole cement pad for us!
